

# MOTHER'S DAY SCAVENGER HUNT

Read the descriptions one at a time and have Mom provide the clues kids will need to find matching items. For kids who do not live with their mom, you can substitute the name of a foster parent, grandparent, or anyone else who takes care of them.

*Find 3 things that are Mom's favorite color.*

*Find something that starts with the same first letter as Mom's favorite movie.*

*Find something related to one of Mom's least favorite chore.*

*Find an ingredient from one of Mom's favorite foods.*

*Find something about as big as Mom's favorite animal.*

*Find something that starts with the same first letter as Mom's favorite book.*

*Find something that reminds Mom of one of her favorite things to do.*

*Find something Mom uses every day.*

*Find something Mom thinks is pretty.*

*Find something you could do to help Mom every day.*

Read Ephesians 6:2. Encourage the kids to remember what they have learned about Mom and use it to honor her in special ways. Perhaps they could use her favorite color the next time they color a picture for her or offer to help with her least favorite chore. Maybe they can help prepare her favorite food or make up a story about her favorite animal to share with her.
